The Life You Deserve in 4 Simple Steps

1. Schedule a Visit

See the advantages of life at Homestead Village for yourself. A visit to our beautiful campus is the best way to get a closer look at how we help you retire the right way.

2. Join the Priority List

Demand for homes often exceeds availability at Homestead Village, which is why we maintain a priority list for future residents. An initial deposit secures your place on the list either as "General" status or "Ready" status and grants you an offer to join our community as homes become available.

Calls are first made to those at "Ready" status and in chronological order from when the individuals joined the list. Preliminary financial information will be requested prior to joining the list.

3. Reserve Your Home

Once you are offered and accept a specific home at Homestead Village, simply deposit 10% of the entrance fee to reserve your home for three months. During this time, it will be fully renovated while you complete paperwork (application form, financial statement, physical form) and prepare to move in.

4. Plan Your Move

Prior to your move-in-date, your entrance fee balance will be due, and you will sign our Residence and Care Agreement. Your monthly fee will begin when you receive your keys.
